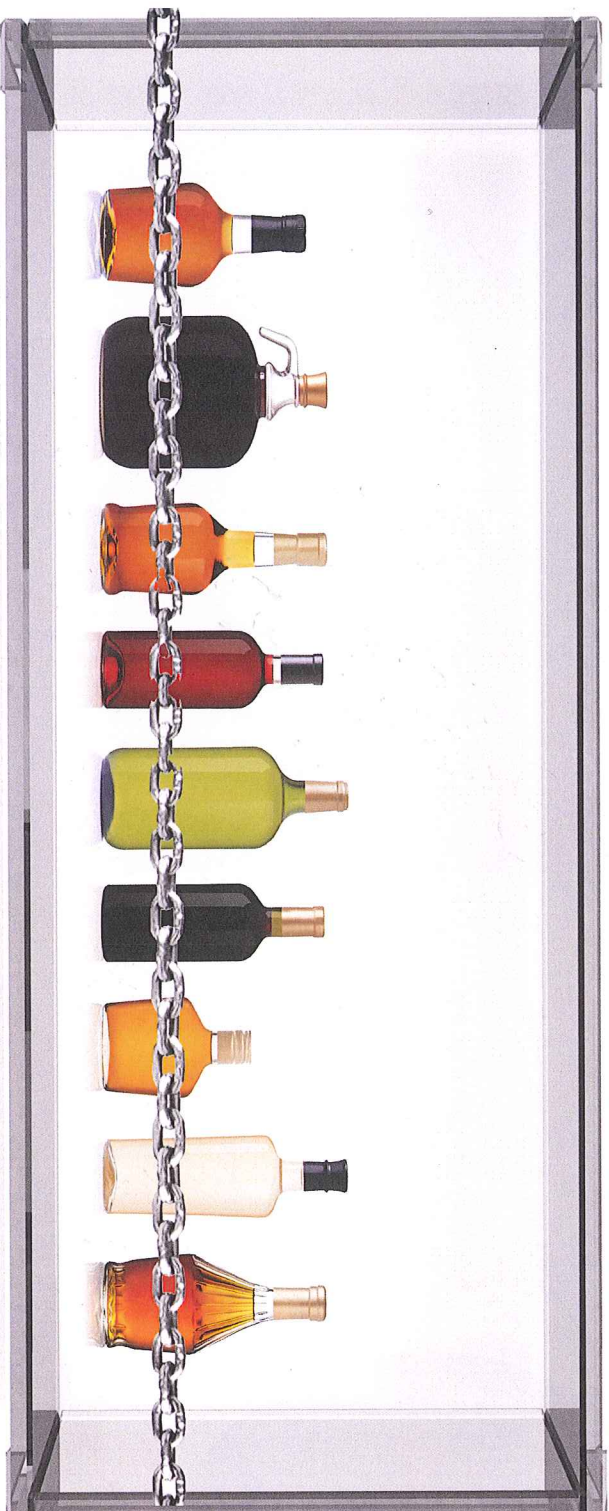


Lock up your alcohol.



Teens might have access.

31% of Southeast high school students report their usual drinking location as “my home”.

46% of Southeast high school students report their usual drinking location as “someone else’s home”.

Note: Southeast Florida includes: Indian River, Martin, Okeechobee, Palm Beach, and St. Lucie Counties

DID YOU KNOW?

¹ in 3 Southeast Florida high school students used alcohol in the past month.

Teens in Southeast Florida have higher rates of alcohol use than Florida students statewide.

8.6% of Southeast Florida high school students drove a car after drinking alcohol in the past month.

27% of Southeast Florida high school students rode in the car with someone who had been drinking in the past month.

Students who reported alcohol use in Southeast Florida are over 10% less likely to report A’s and B’s in the past year than non-using peers.

Southeast Florida high school students who reported alcohol use in the past month reported higher rates of skipping school than their non-using peers.
